

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

1. The Promoters are Integrated Fire Technology (trading name of Fogmaker South Africa (PTY) Ltd), hereafter referred to as IFT.
2. Competitions are open to all South African Residents over the age of 18 who are in possession of a valid identity document; except directors, members, partners, employees, agents or consultants or any other person who directly or indirectly controls, or is controlled by IFT or marketing service providers in respect of the promotional competition, or the spouses, life partners, business partners or immediate family members, or anyone who within a period of 183 days preceding this competition has won any competition organised, promoted, or conducted by IFT, or who resides at the same address as such a winner, or who uses the same telephone number.
